### **HOW SAFETY WILL WORK**



**SOCIAL DISTANCING, households 6 feet apart**



**Players sit 6 feet apart and extend bench to chairs brought from home**



**Umpires 6 feet behind pitchers mound**



**Coaches wear masks, they can take “breaks” when far away from others**



**NO SHARING OF EQUIPMENT! Bring your own helmet, bat and glove, if there is a financial hardship the league can help**



**Bring your own water, no sharing!**



**Coach must designate at least one parent safety monitor for each team .**



The Parent Safety monitor will support the coach by helping make sure that kids that are in the dugout/extended dugout area (chairs from home) are social distancing, masking up and not touching others water or equipment. Ideally, more than one parent would volunteer, so that they alternate games.



We need all parent support to make this season work. It is absolutely essential that all precautions for health and safety be followed to make this season succeed.
